Vendor Transition Announcement: Outreach and Account Management

The Executive Office of Health and Human Services' (EOHHS) Mass HIway has announced a new contract with the Massachusetts eHealth Institute (MeHI) at the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative to develop and deliver services to promote adoption and utilization of health information exchange (HIE) by healthcare organizations statewide. This new contract is a result of an open, competitive procurement.

MeHI is well positioned to help EOHHS increase adoption of Mass HIway and HIE, increase active use of electronic exchange in clinical practice, measure impact that health information exchange has on the delivery of healthcare services, and identify potential new services and opportunities in the growing healthcare IT market.

MeHI is a well-known, trusted resource in the community, and offers valuable expertise and experience in community organizing among healthcare providers, outreach, and education services, technical assessments, and programmatic support for healthcare organizations across the Commonwealth. MeHI has significant experience in both private sector HIT initiatives as well as with the state and federal government health programs, and has worked closely with the EOHHS team on a number of HIway connectivity projects. In addition, MeHI also leads the Commonwealth's Digital Health Initiative, which brings together public, private, academic, and healthcare leaders to build a stronger and more connected statewide digital health ecosystem, and provides an additional platform for the Mass HIway to gain valuable feedback from the larger healthcare community.

This new contract also marks an important change to the Mass Hlway Account Management and Outreach team, which has been staffed and managed by the Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative (MAeHC) since 2012.

The Mass HIway thanks the Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative for their service and contribution to these achievements.

The Mass Hlway, MAeHC, and MeHI are working together over the next several weeks to ensure there is no disruption in services for Participants as a result of this transition, and will continue to collaborate closely in the future to best serve the Commonwealth.

The Mass HIway is looking forward to this new partnership with MeHI, and to employing new strategies and activities to support the next phase of HIE utilization and evaluation in the Commonwealth.

Request for Response Posted: Statewide Event Notification Service

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) has issued a Request for Responses (RFR) on February 15, 2018, in search of a vendor to support the EOHHS Event Notification Service (ENS) Initiative by providing an effective SaaS platform that stores, manages, and shares Admission, Discharge, and Transfer (ADT) information.

EOHHS will facilitate event notification services statewide, with the goal of improving care coordination regarding transitions of care and health care events such as emergency room and hospital admissions, discharges, and transfers.

Responses are currently due by April 17, 2018, at 4:00 P.M. Any amendment to the RFR will be posted to COMMBUYS.



Mass Hlway Transaction Data


9,757,005 Transactions exchanged in January (12/21/17 to 1/20/18)
